


ŠKODA AUTO PRODUCED 2,000,000 SUVs

IN 2020, 40 PER CENT OF ŠKODA AUTO'S GLOBAL DELIVERIES WERE SUVs

The first SUV produced by ŠKODA AUTO was the groundbreaking compact YETI with a variable and practical interior – that was back in 2009. In 2017, the carmaker launched its SUV campaign and gradually introduced the KODIAQ, KAROQ and KAMIQ models. The ENYAQ iV, the brand's first all-electric model on the MEB platform, celebrated its world premiere in September 2019.


SECOND MILLION SUVs IN TWO AND A HALF YEARS

DID YOU KNOW...?

- ŠKODA offers five SUVs in China, the brand's largest market. In addition to the models KAMIQ, KAROQ and KODIAQ, the dynamic variants KAMIQ GT and KODIAQ GT with flowing roofline are also produced there.
- The successful KAMIQ city SUV, introduced in 2019, significantly contributed to the increase in SUV sales. The model series has just surpassed the milestone of 250,000 cars sold.
- ŠKODA will unveil another SUV in March: the KUSHAQ – the brand's first model based on the MQB-A0-IN platform, which ŠKODA AUTO developed in India for the Indian market.
